Please see changes regarding the new security system. There has been a change of dates due to the installation being pushed back. It is very important to see Mike to get your fob as the current gate code will be turned off!!!

We are having a NEW SECURITY SYSTEM installed at the front gate. The gate code 9876 will expire September 15th and will no longer be used after this date.

All members, renters as well as social members will need to see Mike Eberhardt (Harbor Master) for the new access key fob (that can attach to key ring) and a personal gate code. Which will allow you access into the club under a number made for you and your guest. Every slip will receive 2 key fobs. Any additional key fobs needed can be purchased for \$10.00 and \$40.00 for a long range gate opener that will open gate up to 50ft away.

Social Members will receive 1 key fob and personal gate code. Again any additional fobs needed will be \$10.00

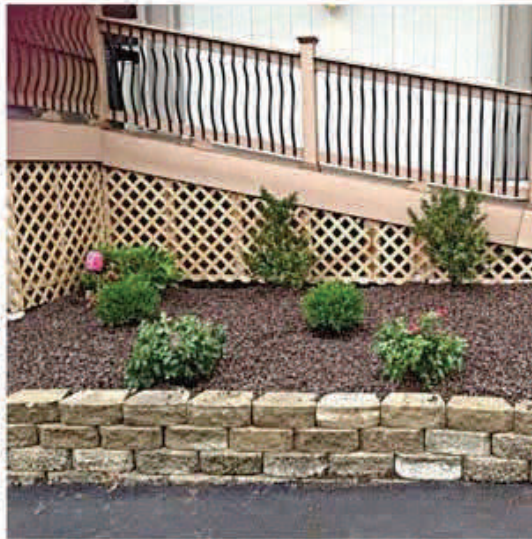

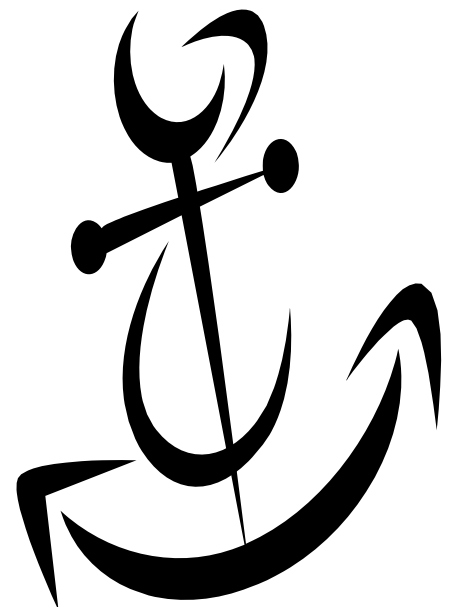

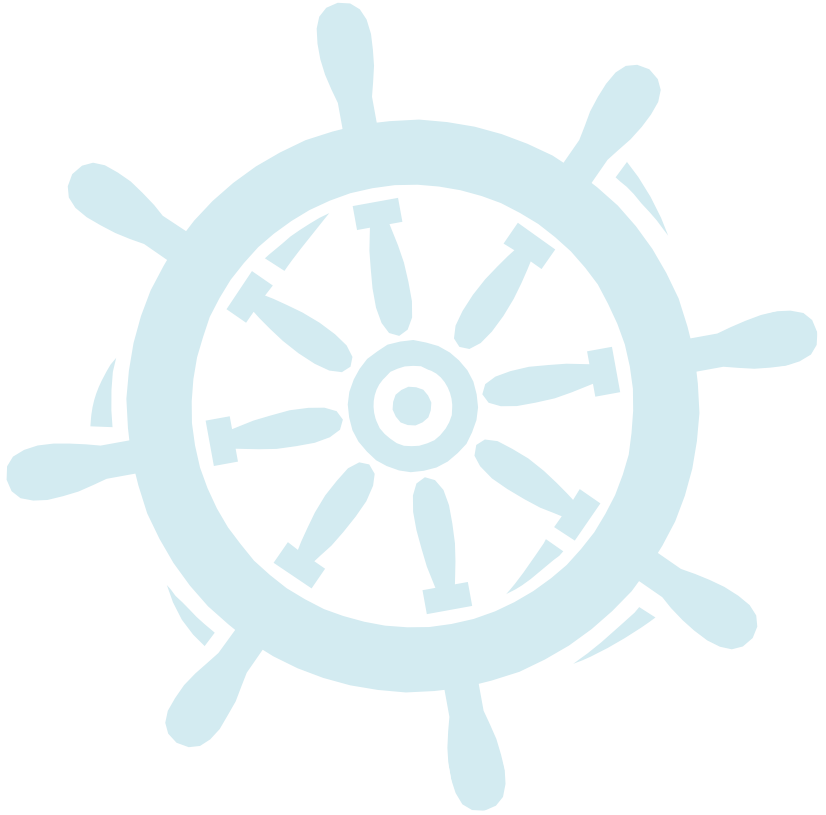
